

Instructions:

1. Complete the Ancestry Registry form (below). The bottom of this form includes permission for the committee to add your information to our collection, share your information with other researchers and to use your submitted information in future publications.
2. Start with your New England Planter ancestor. Fill in his/her name and that of his/her spouse. In the case of other marriages, use only the one line that is your direct ancestor. (indicate if spouse was in marriage 1, 2, 3, etc.)
3. Fill in dates and places of each event where possible. (birth, marriage and death)
4. Dates should be written day, month and year. Use 3 or 4 letters for the month, not numbers. Use 4 digits for the year. Example: 10 Jan 1892.
5. Sources: make a note of the sources of your information. These could be: Family Bibles, books, vital statistics, census records, church records, manuscripts, etc.
6. When the next generation is a female, enter her name first then her spouse. Use maiden surname only.
7. Complete each generation down to yourself. In the case of applying for a certificate for children and or grandchildren, include their generation.
8. If you have more than one New England Planter ancestor, use a separate form for each. If needed, copy the attached form or we can send you more forms.
9. If you use a computer genealogical program, you may send a printout of your pedigree chart, from you to your ancestor as long as it contains the information required.
